Design principles for presentations

Colour

- 1. Use light coloured fonts on dark backgrounds.
- 2. Use colours that contrast in value (lightness/darkness).

Text

- 3. Use fonts with large serifs and large x-heights.
- 4. Limit to one or two fonts (from different categories).
- 5. Squint your eyes at the screen to see what information is legible.
- 6. Stay above 24pt for text size.
- 7. Use left-aligned paragraphs.
- 8. Use capitals and italics only when necessary.
- 9. Match the line length of your words to the length of your ideas.

Similarity

- 10. We tend to group things together that are similar.
- Create cohesive slides by making each element share a characteristic.

Proximity

- 12. We tend to group things together that are close together.
- 13. A single space can make a big difference.

Ratio

- 14. We tend to group elements as part of the same form.
- 15. Use the rule of thirds to organize your information.

Priority

- 16. We tend to prioritize information based on a single difference.
- Choose one characteristic to make something stand out: size, position, value, contrast, number, quantity, personality.

Heading font sizes

Primary	(3:3)	90pt	72pt	60pt
Secondary	(2:3)	60pt	48pt	30pt
Tertiary	(1:3)	30pt	24pt	20pt

Line length and measure

In most cases, the optimum line length for reading is 2.5 alphabets or 70 characters. This helps facilitate reading by giving a comfortable measure for the eyes to move down to the next line.
